

Project Fresh Start - 2009 FACT SHEET



PROJECT FRESH START is a program of the United Way of Portage County Volunteer Center.

PURPOSE: Provide school supplies to students in Portage County who qualify for the free or reduced price lunch program.

The start of a new school year means buying school supplies. For lower-income families it can be a time when money is tight. Project Fresh Start depends on the support of our Portage County community to help provide the school supplies these students need. This year there are 2,637 students eligible to participate in this program.

Beginning in July, individuals and groups will collect donated school supplies. On August 20-21 these supplies will be dropped off at Ben Franklin Junior High in Stevens Point to be sorted and distributed to students on August 22 and 27. Last year, more than 800 students received school supplies through the program. The remaining school supplies were distributed to Portage County schools and affiliate programs serving approximately 300 additional students.

WHO RECEIVES DONATED ITEMS: Project Fresh Start works with Portage County organizations and schools to identify eligible K-12 students who live or go to school in Portage County and are in need of school supplies. 2009 marks the first year that supplies will be offered to **ALL** grades, from K-12. In past years, the program was limited to grades K-9. In 2008, approximately \$67,000 worth of school supplies was distributed.

HOW TO REGISTER?

- Eligible participants should complete a registration form by August 5.
- Registration is available in English, Spanish and Hmong.
- Almond-Bancroft Students can register on site at the Almond-Bancroft School on August 27.

PROJECT FRESH START SUPPLIES: All students in grades K-12 receive a backpack - if needed. Additionally students receive pencils, pens, markers, colored pencils, glue, a pencil bag or box, highlighter, ruler, scissors, notebooks, folders, binders, loose-leaf paper, and other items according to individual grade requirements. HOLD A DRIVE OR BE A DROP SITE: Organizations, groups or businesses may participate by holding their own internal drive and be a Drive Partner. They can also choose to be a Drop Site Partner. These are generally high foot traffic locations where community members can drop off school supplies.
