

INTERFAITH VOLUNTEER CAREGIVERS
Senior Home Repair Volunteer Role Description

Purpose: To directly servicing minor home repair requests on site.

Role Description: The Senior Home Repair Program Volunteer will:

- Correspond with the Senior Home Repair Program Manager
- Complete on-site repairs in accordance with the request of the care receiver
Utilize his/her own tools for the repairs

Qualifications:

- A belief in the shared values of a personal commitment to care and service, the dignity and worth of every person, and the capacity of volunteer care giving to invigorate the life of a community.
- Volunteer must complete application process, which includes volunteer application, background check, and training/orientation.
- Basic carpentry and/or other trade skills.

Application: Volunteer must complete a volunteer application and be screened through a criminal background check.

Training/Orientation: Orientation provided by the Interfaith office. This will require a one hour time commitment.

Time Commitment: Varies according to the volunteer's schedule. Services can range from working on a project twice a week to once every couple months. A single project task can range from 15 minutes to many hours.

Length of Commitment: Minimum of 6 months preferred, but any commitment is appreciated
